Suggested items:

CDs, clothes, furniture, movies, musical instruments, sports equipment... the sky is the limit so get creative! Just don't bring any of the items from this next list:

Items you should NOT bring to the Free Swap Market:

Alcohol, ammunition, bombs, counterfeit merchandise, dogs/cats, drug paraphernalia, fireworks, food, guns, Indiana University property, knives, pornography, tobacco products, used toiletries/cleaning products.
