The Fire Marshall has agreed to allow the Zone II equipment from B03 to stay in the hallway out of B03 until the walls have been completed next week in B14.

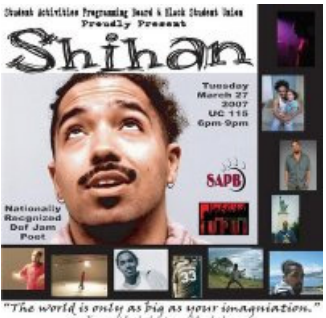
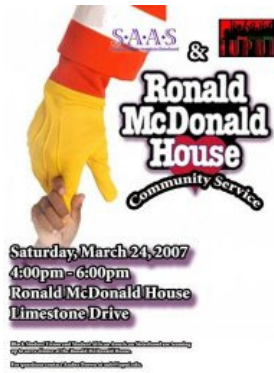
