

**Letter of Agreement between IUPUI School of Journalism and
Department of Communications Studies RE: Master's Degree in Public
Relations**

**Purpose: This letter of agreement outlines courses the Department of
Communication Studies has agreed to allow Public Relations Master's
Degree students to enroll in as a part of their degree program.**

General.

We have agreed that, as a part of the Public Relations M.A. program, the IUPUI Communication Studies Department provide access to Public Relations M.A. students to a series of graduate level courses in Communication that will complement their program of study. Students will be required to take one course, and may take other courses as electives depending upon their focus.

Specific Agreements.

We have agreed that students studying in the Public Relations M.A. program will take, as a part of their core curriculum, C500, Advanced Communication Theory. Students properly identified as accepted into the Public Relations M.A. program will be allowed into this course as a matter of due course without prior approval of the department or the instructor.

We have also agreed that Public Relations M.A. students will be allowed to take additional courses in the Communication Studies graduate program. Those courses may include any of the following:

- C520 Advanced Public Communication
- C526 Effective Media Strategies
- C580 Advanced Organizational Communication
- C582 Advanced Intercultural Communication
- C591 Topics in Applied Communication
- C592 Advanced Health Communication
- C594 Communication and Conflict in Organizations
- C620 Computer Mediated Communication


