1) **September 3 to 5th: Research Coordinator Education Program.** Contact Pam DeWeese (pdeweese@iupui.edu) for information. This is REQUIRED for all research coordinators in the IU School of Medicine that have been working in clinical research for less than two years.

2) **September 24th: Introduction to Clinical Research in Tudor Auditorium** (5th floor Wishard Outpatient West) from 9 to 12 am.
