One letter should be from an IUPUI faculty member who can speak to your academic ability. Letters must be submitted with this application to the Cox Selection Committee by March 15, 2012.

On a separate sheet of paper, please include a personal statement of no more than 250 words about why you should be selected as a Cox Scholar.

4. ESSAY QUESTION

Also, on a separate sheet of paper, answer the following essay question. Your answer should be no longer than 250 words.

- **As an individual, how have you best contributed to your community in the past, and in what ways do you hope to continue contributing to your community as both an individual and professional in the future?**

5. PLEASE ENCLOSE YOUR IUPUI TRANSCRIPT (an unofficial copy printed from One Start is acceptable)

6. PLEASE ENCLOSE A COPY OF ALL W-2s RECEIVED FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR

In order to confirm that the applicant meets the criteria with regard to employment, (IUPUI) requests a copy of the applicants W-@ form. Applicants must submit a W-2 form in order to be considered for an award. By signing and submitting this application, the applicant agrees to disclose any, and acknowledge that there may be confidential information on the W-2 form. The applicant understands that this information will be kept confidential and is only to be used to confirm eligibility for an award.

Please note: Except in the case of extraordinary circumstances as determined by the Cox Scholars Selection Committee, student who are awarded a scholarship, but do not fulfill the full-time requirement may be asked to repay and scholarship monies posted to their Bursar accounts.
4. Student receiving combinations of scholarship that exceed tuition and fees (direct Costs) may need to consult IRS publications 520 and 508 on tax liability for the difference. Please see the IRS website for downloadable copies and information. (The Cox Scholarship Program cannot provide tax advice.) Please note that this scholarship is a significant contribution to paying your estimated cost of attendance and may affect eligibility for additional aid, such as Work –Study, or reduce the amount of current aid.
